Our portfolio emphasizes long-term themes, transparency and alignment of management. This is achieved by a fundamental process which incorporates both financial valuation and ESG analysis of material non-financial factors.

Eternal is India's leading consumer internet platform, operating across food delivery (Zomato), quick commerce (Blinkit), dining-out and events (District), and B2B food supply (Hyperpure). The company's competitive moat is built on its huge network effects and logistics density, boasting an unmatched dark-store footprint and delivery fleet in quick commerce, alongside the widest restaurant network in food delivery. Eternal benefits from structural growth in quick commerce and food delivery, where the segments continue to take share from traditional retail. The company holds a C rating on our proprietary ESG rating system.

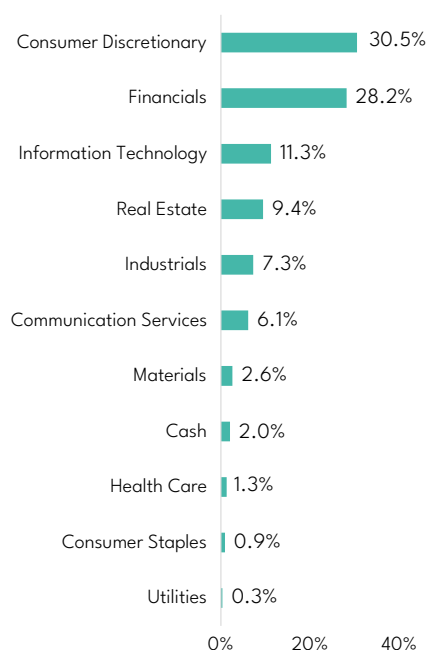

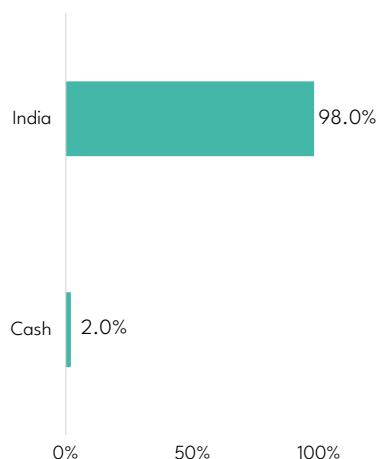
